## Directions to CSR Marine, Commodore Way Yard, Seattle

From I-5 take the Mercer off ramp just north of downtown Seattle. If coming from south of the City it is a left hand off ramp; if coming from the north, it's a right hand ramp. The exit is just north of downtown Seattle.

At the bottom of the short off ramp (Fairview) turn RIGHT. *Quickly get in the third lane from the left.*

At the bottom of the short hill (approx 1 block), turn LEFT (all three left lanes turn left) on Valley and stay in the right hand lane. In a couple blocks, right lane will turn north, following the lake. You will now be on Westlake Ave.

When you reach the top of the lake (you'll be going under two high bridges). Westlake bends to the left and becomes W. Nickerson. You want to be in the left lane when this happens. Stay in the left lane and go straight across Fremont Avenue, heading west.

In approximately two miles as you approach the end of W Nickerson, the left lane will have a sign for Fisherman's Terminal and Emerson St. Follow the left lane, which will take you onto an overpass, which curves northward. You will come to a stop sign where you must make a hard left. You are now heading west on Emerson.

Stay in the left lane for less than ½ mile (passing two traffic signals) and go to the stop sign, just after a bridge which crosses some railroad tracks. This is W Gilman. Turn RIGHT and proceed in a roughly northwest direction for 4/10<sup>th</sup> mile and turn RIGHT onto W Fort St. Go 1/10<sup>th</sup> mile, turn left on 27<sup>th</sup>. At bottom of 27<sup>th</sup> (approx one block) is Commodore Way. CSR Marine is just to your right. The short stretch from Gilman to Commodore involves a couple little turns. Normally this is not a problem, unless parked cars are blocking. Drivers might want to check this stretch out by foot before entering with rig.

It should take about 20-30 minutes to get from the freeway off ramp to CSR Marine.
